Sub: Grant of 2nd Financial Up-gradation under the Assured Career Progression (ACP) Scheme to Shri Narendra Chandra Talukdar, Superintendent (now Retired) – Order - regarding.

In pursuance of the DOPT's O.M. No. 35034/1/97-Estt (D) dated 9th August, 1999 and clarifications issued thereon from time to time, the under-mentioned officer is hereby granted 2nd Financial Up-gradation under the ACP Scheme and is accordingly placed in the higher pay scale with effect from the date mentioned below.

The above financial up-gradation is subject to, inter-alia, the following conditions:-

1. This financial up-gradation is granted with the retention of his old designation and the said financial up-gradation shall not confer any privilege related to higher status.
2. The up-gradation is purely personal to the employee and shall have no relevance to his seniority position. As such, there shall be no additional financial up-gradation for the senior employee on the ground that the junior employee in the grade has got higher pay-scale under the ACP Scheme.
3. His pay shall be fixed under the provisions of FR 22 (I) (a) (1) subject to a minimum financial benefit of ₹ 100 as per the DOPT's O.M. No. 1/6/97-Pay.I dated July 5, 1999. The financial benefit granted under this Scheme shall be final and no pay fixation benefit shall accrue at the time of regular promotion, i.e., posting against functional post in the higher grade.
4. While accepting the said financial benefits, he shall be deemed to have given his unqualified acceptance for regular promotion on occurrence of vacancy subsequently. In case he refuses to accept the higher post on regular promotion subsequently, he shall be subject to normal debarment for regular promotion as prescribed in the general instructions in this regard.
5. This financial benefit contemplates merely placement on personal basis in the higher pay-scale and does not amount to actual / functional promotion of the officer concerned.
6. Option for fixation of pay in the higher scale, shall be exercised within one month from the date of receipt of this order. Such option once exercised shall be treated as final.
